Dear Third Grade Parents and Guardians,

It is an exciting time of year for third graders! Today, third graders learned all about the band instruments and band program for fourth grade next year!. **Band is optional for students to participate next year. However, I highly recommend giving it a try in fourth grade to see if it is something your child enjoys and/or excels in!** 

On the next page, please go over the options with your child, fill out the instrument choice form, sign the bottom, and return it to school <u>no later than Thursday, June 2<sup>nd</sup></u>. Students will choose a first choice and a second choice instrument for next year, then I will select one of those instruments for them to play. I will try my best to give students their first choice, however, it is important that we have a balanced amount of kids on each instrument. There are also other factors that I take into consideration as well (size of instrument/size of child, musical skills, academic skills, responsibility, etc.).

After assigning instruments, I will return a letter to you indicating which instrument your child will play next year along with information on where and when to rent instruments and what supplies and books to purchase. If you already own an instrument that you'd like your child to use in fourth grade, please let me know via email or write it on the form.

#### Please note:

Parents and guardians are required to rent an instrument from a local music store and purchase supplies necessary for that instrument (reeds, swabs, oil, books, etc.). However, Hubbard School has a very limited supply of school-loan instruments available for those who need financial assistance. Please indicate on the form if you think you'll need a school instrument. They are available on a first come first served basis.

#### **Hubbard Beginning Band 2022-2023**

Instruments offered for upcoming 4<sup>th</sup> grade beginners:

- \*Some instruments have special circumstances like cost, size, difficulty level, etc. that will need to be considered when choosing an instrument.



#### **Choosing an Instrument**

Please read about each instrument to help you decide which instrument to play



**Flute:** The flute is a higher sounding instrument, and is played sideways. Students blow across the hole to produce a sound. Consider choosing the flute if you have successfully made a sound on the instrument when you tried it at the demonstration. It is critical that students who choose flute have highly developed fine motor skills because the fingerings are difficult.

**Clarinet:** The clarinet has a large range of notes: it can play low and high! The clarinet is played with a reed on the mouthpiece. Students will need to cover the holes when playing the clarinet. If you successfully covered the holes on a recorder in third grade, consider the clarinet.

**Saxophone:** The saxophone has a large range of notes: it can play low and high! It is also played with a reed on the mouthpiece. The saxophone has the same fingerings (fingers placed on the keys) as the recorder!

**Trumpet:** The trumpet is the smallest brass instrument and can play the highest notes. Students who choose trumpet should have the ability to firm their lips and control their lip muscles.

**Trombone:** The trombone is the largest instrument and makes a low sound. Students will use the slide to play the notes. Students will learn to read the bass clef, so if you are good at note reading, this may be a great choice!

**Baritone:** The baritone plays low notes and reads bass clef like the trombone. But, it has 3 valves like the trumpet and sits on your lap instead of in the air.

\*Baritones are generally more expensive to rent than other instruments. Trumpet or Trombone are a good second choice if baritone is not financially feasible. Some stores offer smaller sized baritones for smaller kids to be successful (Please ask Mrs. Ryan which store offers the smaller baritone).

**Percussion:** Snare Drum, Bass Drum, & Auxiliary instruments (cymbals, tambourine, triangle, etc). Percussion is NOT drum set. Drum set is a different instrument and requires private lessons. You are NOT required to have a drum set at home in order to play percussion. You will rent a snare drum pack.

#### **RENTING AN INSTRUMENT**

- \*In order to participate in the band, most students will rent an instrument from a local music store.
- \*Purchasing an instrument is <u>not recommended</u> until the student has played for at least one year.
- \*Purchasing "cheap" instruments found online (amazon, facebook marketplace, tag sales, etc.) is NOT recommended because they will likely be in very poor condition and need constant repairs.
- \*Information and flyers about renting instruments will be sent home after students have been given their instrument choice for next year.

\*\*Please contact me if there is a financial hardship preventing you from renting an instrument. Hubbard School has a small selection of school instruments that can be borrowed on a first come-first served basis.
